By signing below: I understand that the Islamic Institute Ball Hockey League (IIBHL) is a non-contact league with strict rules against rough play. However, I also understand that protective equipment for my child is my responsibility (helmet, gloves, shin guards, athletic protector). I hereby accept full responsibility for any injury to my child in the course of any ball hockey activity organized or sanctioned by the IIBHL. I hereby clear the IIBHL and its organizers and volunteers, as well as the Islamic Institute of Toronto, of any liability in the event of injury to my child, damage to or theft of his personal property occurring during his participation in any event organized or sanctioned by the IIBHL. I understand that the registration fee of \$50 (\$90 for two brothers, \$135 for 3 brothers) is non-refundable once my child has been placed on a team. I also understand that ball hockey is a team sport and I will try my best to ensure that my child is present for every game so that he does not hurt his team by his absence. I understand that if I have two or more sons playing, there is no guarantee they will be on the same team as they are picked one by one by the coaches, not assigned to a team by the league. I also understand that if my son is 6-11 playing the second game of the night, it could end as late as 10:30 PM and if my son is 12-16 playing the third game of the night, it could end as late as 11:30 PM. I confirm that my child has read the Code of Conduct, or I have read it to him, and he understands and agrees to abide by all its rules.
