INTRODUCTION

The Islamic Institute of Toronto (IIT) is a federally registered ((No. 87208 8299 RR001), non-profit charitable organization. IIT's mission is to nurture and establish Islam as a living reality in the lives of Muslims and to enhance the Islamic identity in the society at large.

IIT's objectives are to:

- provide education & training
- promote scholarly research
- fund Islamic scholarships
- promote community outreach
- sustain Islamic development through endowment (Waqf)

The Institute, established in 1996, has been offering a variety of courses to Muslims of all ages.

The curriculum covers:

- Aqeedah (Islamic Belief)
- Fiqh and Usul al Fiqh (Islamic Jurisprudence & its Principles)
- Qur'anic Studies (Revelation, Compilation, Exegesis, etc.)
- Hadith Studies (Hadith Science & Methodology)
- Arabic Language (Grammar, Syntax, Morphology)
- Islamic History and Civilization (Seerah & Caliphate)
- Contemporary Issues (Modernity, Democracy, Women, Environment etc.)
- Akhlaaq (Ethics and Morals)
- Marriage and Family Life

IIT sponsors a number of camps throughout the year. The annual summer camp caters for 70 to 80 students in the primary grades and provides basic training in Islam; relating Islam to the natural and built environment. The recreational aspect of the camp is a great attraction for the youngsters.

The winter camp caters for students in the secondary grades and in early post secondary institutions. In addition to the Islamic content, the curriculum includes leadership and other life skills for the teenagers.

IIT also hosts a bi-weekly tafseer session on the second and fourth Saturdays of the non-summer months.

THE PROPOSAL

Construction of IIT's state of the art educational campus has commenced in the former City of Scarborough (east end of the City of Toronto).

The proposal is to build an institution that, Insha Allah, would include:

- Institute for Higher Islamic Education
- High School that is uniquely positioned to train young Muslims
- Prayer area
- Conference centre
- Exercise, recreational and athletic sports opportunities
- Library and reading room
- Day nursery
- Seniors' "drop-in" Centre

Join IIT in realizing this ambitious Vision - a Vision to build an educational/recreational institution where Muslims of all ages may pray, ponder and play.



PROGRESS

- Acquired and completed purchase of 8 acres of land in the east end of the City of Toronto at a cost of \$2 Million (Cdn.).
- All municipal and regulatory approvals have been obtained
- Project Manager hired to oversee construction of Phase 1
- Site preparation, excavation and pouring of foundation - complete
- Masonry and Steel, Plumbing and Electrical work underway
