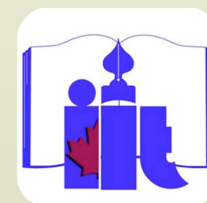

REGISTRATION & CANCELLATION

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

- Hajj registration form
- \$2,000 (per-person) deposit cheque
- Photocopy of passport (just the ID pages that show picture, signature, etc.)
- Passport must not expire prior to May 1, 2013
- Four passport pictures (on a white background, sisters in hijab) - *No other size will be accepted*

CANCELLATION

- Notice of cancellation must be submitted in writing.
- Cancellations received 90 days or more prior to departure are subject to a \$1,000 / person administrative fee.
- Cancellations received less than 90 days prior to departure are *non refundable*.
- In addition to the above, penalties or charges may be imposed by hotels/airlines/bus companies.
